**Entries are per dog per run VERY IMPORTANT!!! READ IN THE INFO PAGE ON SCHEDULE!!!!!!**

**Open** : \$125 each run Open to any handler with a dog of any age.

**Non-Pro** : \$125 each run Open to any handler that does not receive remuneration for training dogs. Any dog may compete.

**Green dog:** \$125 each run This class is for young and/or inexperienced dogs that are not ready to compete in the other Rodear classes offered. *For the 2021 competition calendar year, dogs must be born on or after April 1, 2019*

**Rookie Handler:** \$100 each run Open to inexperienced handlers who have not competed in cow dog competitions. After an individual has won a beginner class 3 times he or she must move up to the other Rodear Divisions.

**VERY IMPORTANT!!!!**

Since there has been a lot of interest in this event and we have numerous handlers traveling a long distance to be here, I don't want to have to limit entries. So please bear with me as I make these decisions. We are limited to daylight hours. We can run 50 dogs per day. My plan at this time is: If we get entries for 50 dogs or less per day we will run 3, 1 day Rodears. If we get more than 50 entries per day we will run 2 Rodears over 3 days. If we do that we will run Rodear #1 starting on Friday July 30<sup>th</sup> with the Open and Non Pro. Saturday July 31<sup>st</sup> we will start the day with Green Dog and Beginner. Then we will go into Rodear #2 with the Open class. Sunday Aug 1<sup>st</sup> we will start with the #2 run for Non Pro, Green Dog and Beginner.

I will make the decision based on paid entries received no later than July 10<sup>th</sup> whether we will run 3 – 1 day Rodears or 2 Rodears over the 3 days.

If it ends up being 3 – 1 day Rodears I will have you send entries for the third day.

**Your entry will not be final until entry fee is received. No exceptions. Deadline for entries is July 10, 2021.** After July 10th if there is room, late entries will be accepted with a \$20 late fee. Phone entries accepted with PayPal or if sent by mail I need to have it in my hand by **July 10, 2021**. You can contact me with entries and I will start a list. Please do not hesitate to contact me with any questions.

Tim and Kathy Garner will host handler dinners Friday and Saturday nights. Concessions will be available during the day.

All works will be Horseback.

The Rodear places a great deal of emphasis on the stockmanship of the handler and the quiet and controlled manner in which the dog maneuvers the cattle. The event is unique from other cow dog competitions in that the majority of the obstacles require both the dog and horse/rider to negotiate.

>Majority of Obstacles will require both the dog and horse/rider to negotiate and complete.

>Quiet and controlled maneuvering of cattle is required. Contestants will be whistled out for excessive chasing or abusing of livestock and/or chasing cattle outside of the boundaries of the course

>There will be ZERO TOLERANCE of any abusive treatment of dogs or horses at Rodear events.

Management reserves the right to disqualify any contestant for behavior deemed by Management to be inhumane.

Class order: Open, Non-Pro, Green Dog, Rookie Handler. Handlers meeting will be 7 am each day

Camping is allowed at the arena. There will be limited electrical hookups for \$20 per day. There will not be water to hook up but there are faucets to fill your water if needed. There are 2 cabins at the arena. If you are interested in one of those contact me asap and I can get you info on them. Call me and I can give you some suggestions for lodging if you don't have living quarters.

Horse pens available, \$10 per horse per night. Camping and horse pens are at the Rodear Arena. Actual Rodear Competition will be at corrals and field north of arena. You will camp and keep your horses at the Rodear Arena. The competition will be held just north of the arena. You drive or ride your horse through the field from the arena to get to the competition area.

Please contact me and give me a heads up on your entries so I can start a list. As stated above I have some decisions to make. So, the sooner I get an idea of entries the better.

Would love to have sponsors for added money. Any money sponsored for added money will go 100% into the payout to handlers.
