The trial will be held August 24 & 25, 2019 at the Lakaeshore Ranch Davis Creek, CA.

We have made a few changes this year. We will be sanctioned by Rodear America. And we have added a Non-Pro and a Youth class. We are excited to get these youth involved. The fururity class will be held on Saturday morning before the sale.

While the philosophy of the Rodear is to have a minimum of rules governing the course, with the focus being on stockmanship, the following will be enforced:

>All works will be Horseback.

>The objective is to complete the course while achieving the most points in the least amount of time.

>In the event of a point tie, tie-breaker will be the quickest time.

>No restrictions on use of the horse/rider to assist dog in maneuvering cattle through the obstacle course.

>Majority of Obstacles will require both the dog and horse/rider to negotiate and complete.

>Quiet and controlled maneuvering of cattle is required. Contestants will be whistled out for excessive chasing or abusing of livestock and/or chasing cattle outside of the boundaries of the course.

There will be a limit of 3 dogs per handler per class (If we do not fill all classes a fourth dog may be entered.)

Classes: Limited to the first 40 paid entries. Rodear America sanctioned

Open: \$115 Open to any handler with a dog of any age.

Non-Pro: \$115 Open to any handler that does not receive remuneration for training dogs. Any dog may compete.

Green Dog: \$100 This class is for young and/or inexperienced dogs that are not ready to compete in the other Rodear classes and have not been shown in any Open or Nursery class.. Once a green dog has won a green dog Rodear class 2 times, the dog must move up to the other Rodear divisions

Beginner: \$100 Open to inexperienced handlers who have not competed in cow dog competitions. After an individual has won a beginner class 3 times he or she must move up to the other Rodear Divisions.

Youth: \$50 Open to any youth 16 yrs and under with any dog.
