Open to any handler that does not receive remuneration for training dogs. Any dog may compete.

Beginner - \$75

Open to inexperienced handlers who have not competed in cow dog competitions. After an individual has won a beginner class 3 times they are no longer eligible for this class.

Waco Bend Ranch Rodear General Information

Date: May 4-5, 2019

Location: Waco Bend Ranch, 842 Phillips Ranch Rd., Graham, TX 76450

The Rodear style of trialing places a great deal of emphasis on the sound stockmanship techniques of the handler and the quiet and controlled manner in which the dog maneuvers the cattle. It is unique from other cow dog competitions in that the course obstacles require both the dog and horse/rider to negotiate. While the philosophy of the Rodear is to have a minimum of rules governing the course, the following guidelines will be adhered to.

- 1. The objective is to complete the course while achieving the most points in the least amount of time.
- 2. In the event of a tie in scores, the faster time will be used to break the tie..
- 3. There are no restrictions on use of the horse/rider to assist dog in maneuvering cattle through the obstacle course.
- 4. The trial course is designed so it will require both the dog and horse/rider to negotiate obstacles.
- 5. Quiet and controlled maneuvering of cattle is required. Contestants will be whistled out for excessive chasing or abusing livestock and/or chasing cattle outside of the boundaries of the course.

Accomodations

The ranch is located 12 miles south of Graham off of Hwy 16. There are several motels available in Graham. Call Dennis Taylor 940-255-2529 if you need assistance or suggestions.

Schedule

Each day will begin with an open handler's meeting at 8:00 a.m. There will also be a non-pro handler's meeting prior to the non-pro class. The class order will be open, non-pro, green dog and beginner. The same class order will run each day (entries permitting).

Lunch will be served each day as close to the noon hour as classes permit.

Waco Bend is a regular working ranch. There is no seating available, we suggest you bring your lawn chairs, umbrellas and whatever other comforts you find useful.

There is limited space for overnighting horses. If you are staying overnight and need accomodations for a horse please contact Dennis Taylor 940-255-2529 to make arrangements in advance.
